SUPPORT SB 1966, THE FIX THE FOID ACT

FIX THE FOID

SB 1966, HFA #2 IS A PAGE AND LINE AMENDMENT THAT MAKES THE FOLLOWING CHANGES TO THE BILL AS AMENDED:

- 1** Sets the FOID card fee to \$20 for both new and renewal applications. The current fee is \$10 and would have been \$50 in the bill as introduced. \$15 of that fee shall go to the State Police Firearm Services Fund and \$5 shall go to the State Police Revocation Reimbursement Fund;
- 2** Caps the amount that a live scan fingerprint vendor can charge for fingerprinting at \$30;
- 3** Delays the effective date 180 days on the provision requiring Illinois State Police to update the back of FOID cards to reflect the changes in this Act;
- 4** Removes the School-Based Mental Health Fund, which was created by the bill as introduced;
- 5** Amends the Mental Health Reporting Fund (a fund receiving money from Concealed Carry License fees) to state that any surplus funds beyond what is necessary for compliance shall be allocated annually in equal parts to community-based mental health services aimed at reducing gun violence and school-based mental health grants. Currently the fund states that surplus money should be used by DHS for mental health treatment programs, but it has not been used for that purpose and sits unused; and
- 6** Adds clarifying language to the Mental Health Reporting Fund that mental health reporting includes reporting to the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS).

SB 1966, HFA 3

A technical amendment fixing a drafting error that deleted the record keeping requirements for person-to-person transfer occurring before the bill goes into effect.
